

For Your Child's Safety and the Safety of Everyone on the bus:

1. **NO GLASS containers**
2. **Balloons are not to be transported at any time.**
3. **NO bottles/cans/open containers, (plastic WATER bottles are acceptable**
4. **ALL carryon items such as band instruments, book bags, and projects must be small enough to be held in the student's lap. Student must be able to board the bus with the item safely without assistance. - If you cannot place it in your lap and it not cover your neck or face, then it is too large and is not allowed.**
5. **NO Large or Bulky Items / Projects - If you cannot place it in your lap and it not cover your neck or face, then it is too large and is not allowed.**
6. **NO Items allowed in the aisle or around rear emergency exit door.**
7. **Sports equipment must be enclosed in a sports bag if it is transported on a school bus.**
8. **NO Animals (live or dead) should be transported on a bus. The animals and their containers will be given back to teacher for storage or parents can transport their child and child's animal/containers.**

Please understand that there are no seat belts or airbags on a school bus, they are designed so that the seat acts as an air bag in the event of an accident or the sudden need to stop in a hurry (applying brakes suddenly) the student's body and head must have an unobstructed movement, so that the seat in front (back of seat) can absorb the impact.
