

WHAT is the L4GA Grant?



- A Federal grant for improving Literacy by pairing community-driven action with research-proven instruction
- Awards take into account: the poverty level of a community, reading scores, and whether a school is identified for state-level support

WHAT is the L4GA Grant?

School districts partner with early learning centers and community organizations to implement community efforts and improve classroom instruction.





WHAT was Pike County's Grant Award?

\$ 839,800.25 per year x 5 years= \$4,199,001.25



WHY do we Need the L4GA Grant?

- to utilize age-specific Literacy assessments
- to identify areas in which growth is needed
- to work with experts who can help us be prescriptive in providing programs that benefit stakeholders




WHEN will the L4GA Grant Funds be Received?
